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## Evaluation and monitoring tools

For monitoring and evaluating the development of the competencies you can use different tools as:

- Assessment tools;
- Questionnaire;
- Interviews;
- Observation;
- Discussions;
- Games;
- Sociometrics;
- Dixit cards;
- Behavioural changes.

For example, some questions from youth pass materials that can help everyone to reflect are:

### Social and intercultural know-how

- How did I create new social relationships? What went right? What hadn't grown well?
- How did the host group classify various habits? Why have I coped with it?
- Have I taken the initiative, turned towards others and helped others?
- When was it that I interacted most effectively with others?
- How did I incorporate my own cultural context to the host community? How did I get theirs?
- Which was my process of intercultural learning during the project?
- How did I cope with the cultural shock (if I came up against one)?
- How did I manage the conflicts? How did I solve those problems?
- How have I developed my ability to function inside a team?
- What other social skills did I develop during the course of this project?
- To what degree have I raised cultural self-knowledge: a greater understanding of my own cultural values, expectations and assumptions and the impact of interacting with people I did not know?
- In what way did I develop cultural competence, adaptability and better understanding of difference?
